

Maverick GPS Navigation



This **free** mapping and navigational App is only available on Android smartphones and tablets. Get it through the Play Store. There is also a YouTube video showing how to use the various features.

There are a number of different map options but the great thing is that the **OS Explorer Map** is included (go to menu and More maps). Scroll the map to anywhere you want and zoom for greater detail.

When you scroll the map more of it is loaded and remains in cache so that later you can view the map even when not connected to the internet. The Blue spot indicates your position on the map and follows as you walk - very helpful if you get lost!

Routes can be recorded and saved.



Click this to centre map on where you are.



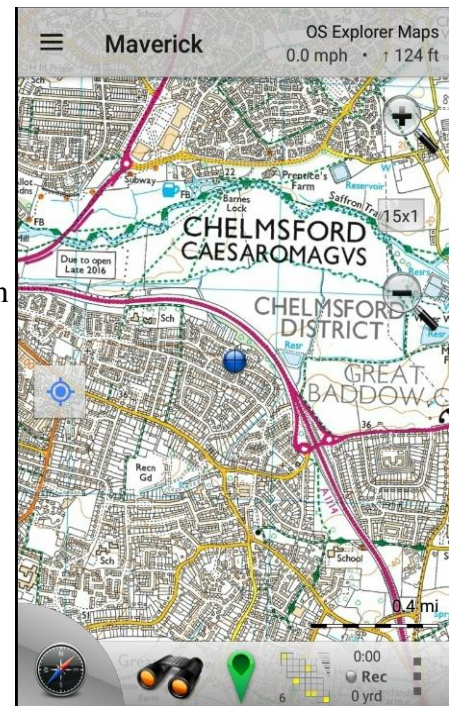
Click this to start, stop or continue recording distance.

The direction indication will only work if your smartphone has an inbuilt electronic compass. Be aware that if you keep your smartphone in a case with a magnetic clasp, it will interfere with the compass reading.

It is worth looking at other features like search and settings to customise for your own use. Two examples:

Tap the two indicators at the top right to set different displays.

There is a faint central cross wire, which if you place over a road and tap the green balloon, it can be linked to Google Street View.



A Maverick Pro version with extra features can be bought for £5.95, but most people should find this free version very useful.
